General remarks

The project has managed well to deal with changes necessitated by the policy debates and changes of the EU Supply Chain Directive, and this has in fact led to greater relevance in terms of being involved in policy debates at the European level and contributing to the ongoing development of implementation guidelines. Overall, the project is very well on track and already produced a considerable amount of scientific publications and public/media communications. Focusing on two paradigmatic case regions (Chile as a democratic context and Uganda with an authoritarian regime), the project promises to produce results that are broadly transferable. The presentation also showed great sensitivity to the power imbalances involved in the project context and highlighted useful strategies to deal with these situations (e.g. working with existing networks, supporting network and capacity building where they do not exist). Emphasizing the important role of implementation and innovative ways of supporting implementation the project addresses particularly well the topic of transformation and how to actually contribute to changes beyond high-level policy statements and visions.
