

Lectures, excursions, company visits, teamwork in interdisciplinary and international teams, project work supervised by teachers, and by work-life partners.












Pushing the limits

- ASSESSMENT METHODS AND CRITERIA


Preliminary work in national teams, online attendance requirement, active participation in lectures, workshops, project assignments, and presenting results.




• COURSE FEE IS 280 € /student
