Application process	After nomination, students will receive an e-mail from our incoming coordinator with further information and a link to register in our application platform (Mobility Online).  Students are asked to fill in the online application, provide several application documents and choose their courses via Mobility Online.

Language requirements	English and/or German at least at B2 (C1 recommended) based upon the Common European Framework of Reference.  An entrance test in English is NOT required.  Students who would like to choose courses taught in German are asked to provide a language performance statement (stating their language level; mir B2) from their home university.
