Nomination process	A nomination link will be sent out to partner institutions at the beginning of the nomination period for the academic year 2025/26.
Nomination deadlines	<p>Winter semester: 5 May 2025</p> <p>Summer semester: 3 November 2025</p>
Application process	<p>After the nomination has been checked, students receive an e-mail with further information and a link for registering on our application platform (Mobility Online).</p> <p>Students are asked to fill in the online application, provide several application documents (deadline 26 May / 25 November) and choose their courses via Mobility Online (June / December).</p>
Application registration deadlines (initial registration in Mobility Online)	<p>Winter semester: 18 May 2025</p> <p>Summer semester: 17 November 2025</p>

Language requirements	<p>English and/or German at least at B2 (C1 recommended) based upon the Common European Framework of Reference.</p> <p>An entrance test in English is NOT required.</p> <p>Students who would like to choose courses taught in German, are asked to provide a language performance statement (stating their language level; min B2) from their home university.</p>

Health Insurance	<p>Students from European Countries, who have a European Health Insurance Card, do not require additional health insurance. However, depending on the personal situation, additional travel insurance should be considered.</p> <p>Students from other countries will need health insurance that covers the full duration of their study period in Austria.
