Languages

Sufficient knowledge of the language of instruction is required. Your proficiency has to correspond to CEFR-level C1. Your language skills are going to be tested in the entrance exam.

- Standardized application form (online)
- Signed curriculum vitae (not handwritten)
- Certificates and diplomas:
 - Exam of vocational middle school/ certification of vocational training
 - Secondary school- leaving exam/ high school diploma/ transcript of final school year
 - Transcript of records
 - Bachelor Diploma
- Birth certificate
- Proof of citizenship or copy of your passport
- Austrian residence registration certificate or EU residence permit

After you submitted your complete application, we will check if you fulfil the admission requirements. If this is the case, an invitation to sit the entrance examination will be sent to you by e-mail.

The entrance examination takes place during the summer semester at our university in Vienna. It consists of a presentation meeting or interview and a multiple-choice test.

Depending on your documents you may have to pass supplementary examinations to achieve equality to Austrian secondary-school leaving certificates. You will receive details about all exams you need to take and details for your preparation in time.
